## Welcome and Review Agenda

Chair Don Barber called the meeting to order at 5:35pm.

## 1. Approval of 2010 Budget (vote)

The Greater Tompkins County Municipal Health Insurance Consortium Board of Directors, reviewed and questioned with great detail the 2010 budget at the September 24<sup>th</sup> meeting. Several questions arose concerning cost and expense over the first three months, while the reserves were developing.

The Internal Coordinator line-item was questioned, not as a need, but at what capacity. Mr. Locey provided a hypothetical situation. If a municipality received three phones calls from their retirees about a particular issue or concern, the municipally would than contact the Internal Coordinator who would either provide the appropriate information or contact either the (Third Party Administrator) TPA Excellus BCBS or the Consortium Consultant in order to ensure that their issues are resolved.

## 2. Approval of PPO Plan (vote)

Relation and authority was questioned as it pertained to Benefits. Mr. Locey ensured the BOD that the Benefit Plans are independent of Excellus BCBS. They can't be changed by the Insurance Company. The Consortium files with The State of New York, not Excellus BCBS.

## What if something is not available within the Consortium structure?

The municipality can still provide additional benefits outside the Consortium's offerings, but at their own risk, all claims associated with that additional benefit will be subject to the single entity, not the group as a whole.

## Consortium's Chief Fiscal Officer

Mr. Locey provided the BOD a memorandum on the election of the Chief Financial Officer. Comparing the Municipal Cooperative Agreement's (MCA) current language and proposed revised language. The revised version solves two issues, one helping the Consortium provide the most qualified person for the position, following the Nominating Committee's recommendations, and second is compliant with New York State Laws and Regulations. Essentially, the revised language would allow the BOD to choose from director OR alternates when selecting a Chief Fiscal Officer, thus permitting the appointment of the City Controller as CFO.

## Process for Requesting a New Benefit Plan.

What if a municipality requests new plan?

The Greater Tompkins County Municipal Health Insurance Consortium Board of Directors would review the plan, and then look at cost and risk factors. The Board of Directors votes to offer or not offer the plan as one of its menu items.
